Fitness for Transport Vehicles in Section 56 of Motor Vehicle Rules-1988 Provision has been made for issuance of certificate of Transport Vehicles and issuance of certificate of Non Transport Vehicles. As well as of completion of 15 years of non-transporting

Registration in vehicles can be done. As per Act 1989 section 172a Periodic Inspection of Vehicles - There is provision to maintain the safety of the passengers on the roads in the state and reduce the pollution.

Now Vehicle fitness assessment work is done manually in RTOs. Instead, this operation can be done with the help of multi-faceted transparency as well as the use of technology, recognizing the need to make such an arrangement, the Central Government on September 23, 2021, recognition of automated testing station by adding sub-rule-63 in rule 1989 of vehicle rules-172a,

Including registration of automated testing stations

Process, eligibility of applicants, conflict of interest, structural requirement, manpower requirement,

Preliminary of Registration Certificate, Procedure and Procedure of Testing, Re-Tate Procedure, Appeal Provisions, Orders and Assessments to be reviewed in a timely manner, Regional of the Registration Authority, etc.

Provisions, standards for tests at automated testing stations, for automated testing stations.

All important matters such as equipment procuremen are covered in detail.

With this in mind, the state government has also issued notifications to the state government last night.

Establishment of automated testing stations on PPP basis

The decision to develop is taken by the Government. Matters other than the policy of the Central Government, additional matters covered by the government to make the whole process easier and clearer by covering is resolved.

- 1) The RTO will be the Registering authority of Automated vehicle Fitness station. Any disputed regarding this the Ministry, Transport dept. will be Authority.
- 2) Wanting to get 'Preliminary Registration Certificate' for setting up an automated testing station, the applicants have approached the Commissioner of Transport Dept., with application form along with required documents, Fees as per rules 63 (6) of Rule-1989.
- 3) No single applicant can apply for setting up of more than 10 (ten) stations.
- 4) The applicant has a center at the time of applying for the 'Certificate of Preliminary Registration'. According to the government's policy, the place

where the automated testing station is to be set up is its own or must be leased for 10 (ten) years class. 'Preliminary Registration Certificate' can be issued but within 6 (six) months from the date of application. If the lease agreement of for 10 (ten) years is not submitted till date, then the certificate will be revoked.

- 5) The validity of 'Preliminary Registration Certificate' will be 12 (twelve) months. During which the applicant will have to Prepare Automated Testing Station and 'Registration Certificate' in accordance with Central Government norms
- 6) The fees of testing the vehicle from vehicle owners is collected by Operator of ATS as per CMVR 1989 rule 81. The fitness certificate fee will be paid to the Govt. by Vehicle Owner.
- 7) The entire process and result by ATS is online as per Guide lines of Govt. of India. All the reports to be submitted to the RTOs by ATS operator on daily basis.
- 8) If any dispute of result of Fitness report, the complaints should be registered to the Regional RTO officer.
- 9) The interested agencies of ATS on PPP basis, have to follow all the instructions, Specifications of machineries, testing method as per GSR of 23/09/2021 by MoRTH. They have to follow as per GSR and will have to modify as per changes require as per Govt. of India and Govt. of Gujarat strictly.

The instructions of Central Govt. as per GSR have to follow and changes made by Govt. strictly.
